### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### RYAN METZROTH, OF, MCLEAN RAIDERS

Ryan Metzroth of the McLean Raiders, one of the newest franchises in the Clark Griffith League has been selected as the sixth Player of the Week for the 2007 Clark C. Griffith Collegiate Baseball League season. Metzroth, an outfielder from the University of Richmond, hit .400 for the week with two doubles and two home runs. He collected seven RBIs and scored nine runs to help the Raiders go 4-3. On July 14 against the Maryland Orioles, Metzroth went 3-for-4 with four RBI to help lead the team to a 10-9 win. In the Raiders' July 15 victory against the Bethesda Blue Caps, Metzroth went 2-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored. The Agoura Hills, Calif. native hit his fifth homer of the season that night. Metzroth led the league in hits for the week with 10 and with RBI with 10 as well.



**BACKGROUND:** At the University of Richmond, Metzroth appeared in 58 games during the 2006 and 2005 seasons...he lettered twice in baseball and once in cross country at Agoura High School...he was captain of his high school baseball team as a senior...named an American Legion All-Star after his junior and senior high school season...as a senior, he hit .420 with 34 RBI.

### PITCHER OF THE WEEK

#### SCOTT EASTMENT, RHP, FAIRFAX NATIONALS

Scott Eastment of the Fairfax Nationals has been selected as the sixth Pitcher of the Week for the 2007 Clark C. Griffith Collegiate Baseball League season. Eastment, a right-handed pitcher and rising junior at Frostberg State University, threw a complete game shutout this week to help the Nationals to a 3-2 record. The Warrenton, Va. native threw 7 innings of a doubleheader against the Gaithersburg Giants of the Maryland Collegiate Baseball League on July 14. In the contest, he struck out five batters, and only allowed four hits and two walks. He ended the week with a 0.00 ERA and a .160 opposing batting average. The victory allowed Eastment to go 3-0 on the season.

**BACKGROUND:** With Frostburg State this spring, Eastment went 8-2 and threw 78.2 innings and struck out 37 batters...Before attending FSU, Eastment attended Georgetown University...Eastment lettered four times at Paul VI Catholic High School.

## **WEEKLY NOTES**

- The Vienna Senators went 7-0 on the week. The Senators, who are in first place, lead the league in team batting and team pitching. The Senators had a .341 team batting average and collected 88 hits and 71 runs this week. The team ERA was 2.14 and the Vienna pitchers struck out 77 batters in seven games this week as well.
- The Vienna Senators will be hosting the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Burt Crump Classic on July 22 at 2 p.m. at Waters Field. The Classic pairs up the Senators against the Vienna American Legion Post 180 club in a friendly contest, which honors legendary coach, Burt Crump. Crump coached the Post 180 team to several district and state titles.
- The Clark Griffith League will be hosting the Jacobs Cup Post Season Tournament from July 27 to July 29 at Waters Field. The event will be held before several teams leave for post season play in national tournaments.
- Among other top players in the League this week were: Xavier Qualls of the Vienna Senators, who batted .526 with five doubles and six RBI, John Barrett of the DC Grays, who batted .500 with a triple, two home runs and 6 RBI, and Eric Mruczek of the McLean Raiders, who batted .333 and had 10 RBI.
- Among other top pitchers in the League this week were: Aaron Loup of the Vienna Senators, who threw eight innings, struck out 10 batters and only allowed 1 ER for a 1.12 ERA, Nate Newman of the Vienna Senators, who threw eight innings and fanned 11 batters and only allowed 1 ER, and Kevin Moreland of the McLean Raiders went 1-0 and had a save in four appearances. He struck out five in eight innings.
