PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JUAN MUJICA, OF, DC GRAYS

Juan Mujica of the DC Grays has been selected as the seventh Player of the Week for the 2007 Clark C. Griffith Collegiate Baseball League season. Mujica, an outfielder from Southern University, hit .345 for the week and collected three RBIs to help the Grays go 4-3. He hit a double, stole three bases and scored seven runs this week as well. In the Grays' July 22 victory against the Bethesda Blue Caps, Mujica went 2-for-5 with an RBI and two runs scored. The rising junior from Caracas, Venezuela went 2-for-4 and knocked in one run against the Maryland Orioles on July 21. Mujica led the league in batting average, runs, doubles and stolen bases this season. He is also tied for the lead in hits for the league. He was a strong leader for the DC Grays this season.



BACKGROUND: This spring with Southern University, Mujica batted .318 with two triples and 15 RBI in 25 games

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

BILLY TINSLEY, LHP, VIENNA SENATORS

Billy Tinsley of the Vienna Senators has been selected as the seventh Pitcher of the Week for the 2007 Clark C. Griffith Collegiate Baseball League season. Tinsley, a left-handed pitcher and rising senior at Winthrop University, made two appearances and held opposing batters to a .216 batting average in the Senators' way to a 6-1 record this week. He threw 10 innings, and struck out 15 batters. He ended the week with a 0.00 ERA and walked just three batters. Tinsley, a transfer from George Mason University, combined for a shutout on July 20 against the McLean Raiders. In that game, he went 8 innings and struck out 10. Tinsley was an important part of the Senators' rotation this spring. For the team, he went 3-1 with a 3.41 ERA. He struck out 36 batters this season and only issued eight walks this season.



BACKGROUND: With Winthrop this spring, Tinsley made three appearances and had a 2.70 ERA...with George Mason in 2006, he made 16 appearances and pitched 27 innings. In 2005 with the Patriots, he won one game and threw seven innings...at Bishop Denis O'Connell High School, he earned all-Washington Catholic Athletic Conference and All-State honors as a junior. He went 16-4 as a career at O'Connell High School.

WEEKLY NOTES

- The Vienna Senators went 6-1 on the week. The Senators, clinched the club's ninth league championship, lead the league in team batting and team pitching. The Senators have a .317 team batting average and collected 72 hits and 6 home runs this week. The team ERA is 0.93 and the Vienna pitcher struck out 57 batters in seven games this week as well. The Senators will travel next week to participate in the National Baseball Congress World Series in Wichita, Kansas.
- The Clark Griffith League hosted the first annual Jacobs Cup Post-Season Tournament on July 27 at Paul VI High School and Waters Field. The McLean Raiders will not be competing in the event as they are participating in the All-American Amateur Baseball Association National Baseball Tournament in Johnstown, Pa. The Fairfax Nationals will take on the DC Grays at 4pm at Paul VI and the Vienna Senators will host the Bethesda Blue Caps at 4pm at Waters Field. The winners of the two games will go head-to-head for the Jacobs Cup title at 8pm at Waters Field. Congressman Tom Davis (R-Va. 11th District) will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at 8pm.
- Some Clark Griffith League single-season records were broken this season. Nick Wheeler of the Vienna Senators collected 46 RBIs this season. The old record was 42, which was held by Jared Dufault of the Arlington Senators in 1999. Alex Gregory of the Fairfax Nationals broke the triples record, by smacking six this season. Three players (Marshall Berhard, Geoff Milsom and Daniel Burton) had the record with five triples. Aaron Loup tied the record of a 1.000 win percentage this season by going 8-0. Victor Cepeda and Brian Cummings both have a 1.000 win percentage. The Senators smacked 40 total team home runs this season, surpassing the record of 33 team home runs made by the Reston Hawks in 2005.
- Among other top players in the League this week were: Will Cooper of the Bethesda Blue Caps, who batted .550 with three-extra base hits and five RBI, Jabari Graham of the DC Grays, who batted .440 with three-extra base hits and 7 RBI, and Ryan Heroy of the Vienna Senators, who batted .429 with two home runs and six RBI.
- Among other top pitchers in the League this week were: Aaron Loup of the Vienna Senators, who threw eight innings and struck out nine batters for his eighth win, Joe Mizzoni of the McLean Raiders, who threw seven shutout innings and fanned four batters, and Grant Dayton of the Fairfax Nationals went 1-0 in two relief appearances and struck out six in four innings.
